Award overview

The **Outstanding environmental health team** award recognises a team which has delivered a significant improvement to health, wellbeing and environment over the past three years (May 2021 to April 2024).

Entries and nominations are expected to be diverse and to showcase the breadth of work being carried out by environmental health professionals and services across all employment sectors in the UK. At least one person on the team must be a current full CIEH member.

Judges will give specific consideration to:

- Improvement to public health and wellbeing
- Reduction in health inequality and improvements to public protection
- Promotion of sustainability

Entry criteria:

- Size of team and areas of control.
- **Summary of a project/initiative** you are most proud of in terms of a significant impact to health, wellbeing and environment.
- **Brief and objectives:** clear and SMART objectives of the project/initiative and expected outcomes.
- Rationale, research and planning: rationale behind the project/initiative and demonstration of systemic planning.
- **Strategy and implementation:** explanation of key activity, partnerships and collaborations.
- Measurement and evaluation: achievements including evidence relating back to SMART objectives, budget and cost-effectiveness.
- **Challenge overcame** which best demonstrates the team's approach. What happened? How did you overcome it? How did this affect department practice?

Overarching summary:

In addition to your entry, an **overarching summary** must be submitted to give an outline of this team's achievements. For the winning entry, this summary will be used in marketing material for promotion of the winning team.
