

CIEH Level 3 Award in Food Safety Supervision for Manufacturing (Refresher) Syllabus

A Food safety legislation

Candidates should understand how food business operators can ensure compliance with food safety legislation and be able to:

- i Summarise the importance of food safety management procedures.
- ii Explain the responsibilities of employers and employees in respect of food safety legislation and procedures for compliance.
- iii Explain how the legislation is enforced.
- iv Outline the requirements of food safety audits.

B Good food safety practice

Candidates should understand the application and monitoring of good food safety practice and be able to:

- i Justify the importance of high standards of personal hygiene.
- ii Explain procedures for cleaning and disinfection including the need for workplace and equipment schedules.
- iii Explain procedures to control contamination and cross-contamination.
- iv Describe the importance of and methods for waste disposal.
- v Describe the importance of and methods for pest control.

C Food safety management procedures

Candidates should understand how to implement food safety management procedures and be able to:

- i Describe the consequences for food safety from microbial, chemical, physical and allergenic hazards.
- ii Describe methods and procedures for controlling food safety to include critical control points, critical limits and corrective actions.
- iii Explain the requirement for temperature control.
- iv Explain the importance of traceability.
- v Explain the importance of continually reviewing and, as appropriate, improving the organisation's procedures.

D Training and communication

Candidates should understand the role of supervision in food safety management procedures and be able to:

- i Explain the requirements for induction and on-going training of staff.
- ii Explain the importance of monitoring and reporting in food safety management.
