

CIEH Risk Assessment Principles and Practice

The CIEH risk assessment qualification has been successfully re-accredited by QCA as the CIEH Level 3 Award in Risk Assessment Principles and Practice. The qualification, which has been endorsed by the Sector Skills Council, has migrated to level 3 as the qualification is aimed at supervisory level employees.

The content and mode of assessment is exactly the same as it was before its re-accreditation.

There are three amendments that come into effect:-

The qualification's QCA accreditation number has changed

Guided Learning Hours (GLHs) are increased to 20. The 20 GLHs includes estimated time the majority of candidates may take to complete both the course duration (minimum 7 hours), and the assignment.

There is now a 'merit pass' grade, which is awarded when candidates achieve more than 80%, as with all other QCA-accredited Vocationally Related Qualifications.

Centres who request deliveries after 1 April 2007 will be issued with new level 3 candidate Assessment records (CARs). The CIEH will also continue to accept assignments on the level 2 Candidate Assessment Records (CARs) until 31 December 2007.

All successful candidates will from 1 April 2007 be presented with level 3 certificates.

The *Risk Assessment – Principles and practice* training pack and course book remain unchanged. All items are available to order at the same price.

Trainers and centres currently registered for the level 2 award will be automatically registered for the level 3 award.
