Assignment marks

A = the sum of the two assignment marks (which together will provide an overall percentage)

Candidates must achieve a minimum mark of 30 in each assignment before they are eligible to sit the examination.

If the examiner reduces a mark to below 30, the candidate will be referred.

Examination marks

B = examination mark (as percentage)

Candidates must achieve mark of at least 60% in the written examination to attain the advanced certificate.

Candidates who fail to achieve a mark of at least 60% in the written examination will be failed.

Final mark

$(50\% \times A) + (50\% \times B) = \text{Final Mark}$

Candidates must achieve a final mark of at least 60% to pass.

90 – 100% = Distinction

75 – 89% = Merit

60 – 74% = PASS

0 – 59% = FAIL
