

HHSRS: damp, mould, and excess cold

This course has been revised to provide direct reflection on the implications of the Awaab Ishak case and the need for thorough and detailed inspection and understanding of the causes of damp and mould and excess cold, assessment of these hazards and their health effects using HHSRS, and remediations that may be applicable.
