Our 2019 highlights included:

- Our new **What is environmental health?** campaign highlighted the importance of environmental health, raising the profile of the profession and inspiring the next generation of Environmental Health Practitioners
- Gained seats on two project boards at the Ministry of Housing Communities and Local Government – selective licensing independent review and the scoping phase of the HHSRS review
- Relunched our flagship Noise Survey
- Supported a successful Private Members Bill led by Karen Buck MP – the Homes (Fitness for Human Habitation) Act – which became law in March 2019

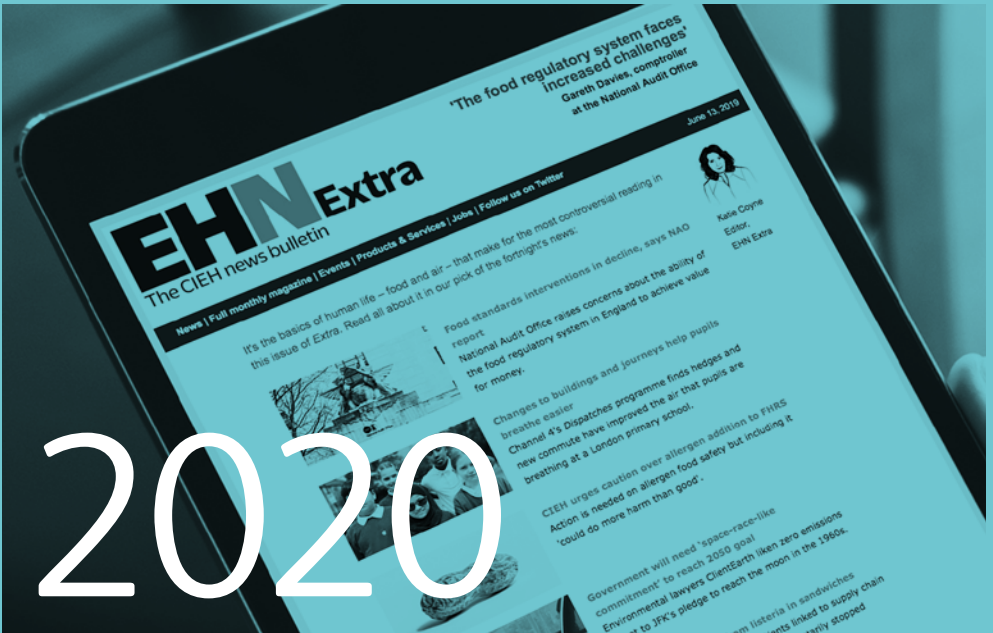

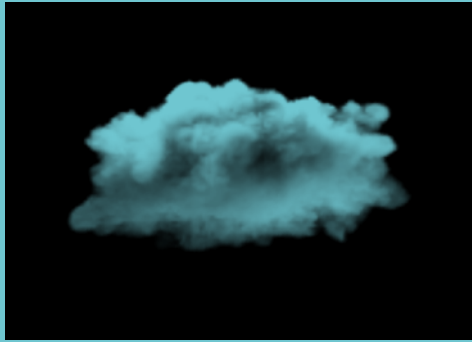
